

HEALTHFEST 2009

Screening Highlights

- 106 men received a Prostate Cancer Screening
- 448 Flu Shots were administered
- 768 people tested for HIV and 1,121 received HIV/AIDS Prevention Education - this year HealthFest hosted the national Black AIDS Institute *Greater Than Campaign*
- 1,108 people were tested for Diabetes
- 84 adults and 263 children were provided a Vision Screening resulting in 63 children being fitted for and provided with free glasses during the event
- 114 individuals were provided a Hepatitis C Screening
- 74 individuals were provided Hepatitis A & B Screenings
- 131 people received a comprehensive Kidney Disease Screening valued at approximately \$1,000/each
- 550 individuals received a Dental Screenings were provided
- 200 people received Fluoride Varnish Applications
- 100 children received Dental Sealants
- 210 people received a Chiropractic Exam & Adjustment
- 482 people were tested for Syphilis
- 110 individuals were screened for Liver Disease
- 1,620 people received a Blood Pressure Screening
- 281 people received a Medical Consultation
- 387 individuals had a Cholesterol Screening

History of Outcomes

HealthFest 2005:	3,337 screenings
HealthFest 2006:	7,112 screenings
HealthFest 2007:	19,035 screening
HealthFest 2008:	27,858 screenings
HealthFest 2009:	35,365 screenings

Overall increase since 2005 = 960%

2008 was the first year HealthFest tracked the value of free care provided. HealthFest vendors provided more than \$491,000 in free health care. The 2009 event almost doubled in value providing \$898,253 of free care. These values do not include education imparted during the event. The educational value of HealthFest is **PRICELESS!**
